

BATTING CAGE STANDARDS

General Usage –

The cage is for the exclusive use of softball teams and individuals involved directly with the softball programs of WLSA and WLHS (merely being a resident of West Linn does not qualify for batting cage usage). No one under 16 years of age should be allowed to use the batting cage without adult supervision. The facility should not be used for storage of equipment or any valuables.

General Condition –

The floors should be free of field equipment, ball buckets, and clothes. The pitching lane floors should be clear of all balls, buckets, and hitting tees. No clothes should hang on walls or fences. The only equipment in cage should be the two pitching machines.

General Maintenance -

The concept is to leave the cage in the same condition you found it.

When leaving the cage:

- Make sure both pitching machines are powered off.

- Pick up all balls and place in buckets.

- Leave buckets by pitching machines.

- Remove all clothes, shoes, bats, water bottles, and field equipment.

- Place all trash in containers outside cage.

- Turn off radio and lights.

- Make sure all four doors are secure with locked padlocks.

Key Maintenance –

Please do not allow your key to leave your possession.

Please do not allow copies to be made of your key.

Please do not give out the combination to lock box.
